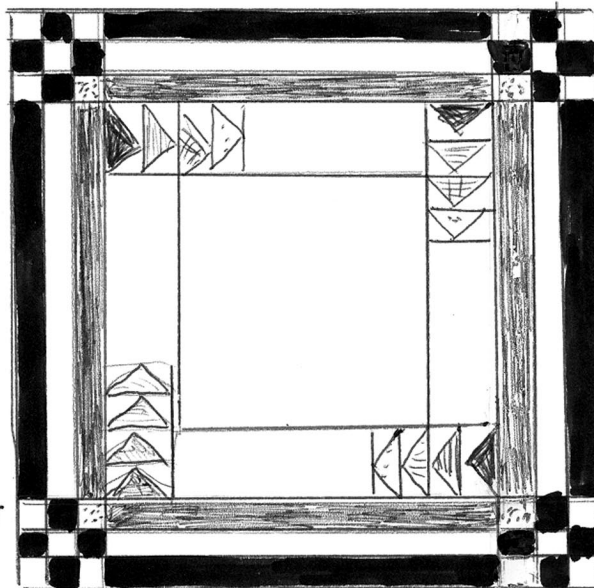




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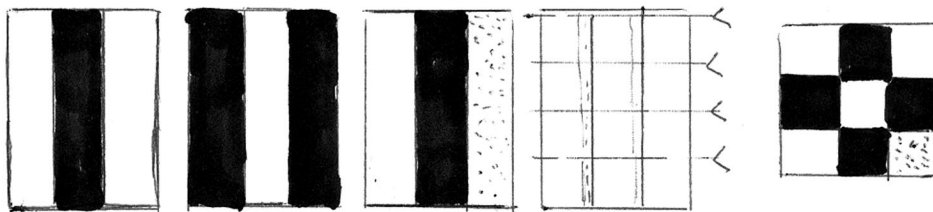
### MYSTERY SCRAPPY SAMPLER II –Block 4, 9-Patch Border

Audition your fabric colors for three outside border strips as shown in drawing. I used a light in the middle and a medium touching the quilt and then a dark of the same color family for the outside.

Cut (4) 2 1/2" strips x width of fabric of each color strip for outside border, then cut off a 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" end strip from each color to use in the 9-patch corner blocks, making sure long strip remains at least 30". Sew your three border strips together, repeating until you have four sets.

Audition your corner square fabrics. Whatever depth of color used in the center border strip should be the outside corners and middle of the 9-patch. I used a different but similar light. I had to make my corner blocks twice...found the medium was not strong enough to be used and switched to the dark. (You will not use one color of the 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips) I also added a different inside corner to bring in one of the quilts previously used fabrics. Using the 10 1/2" strips:

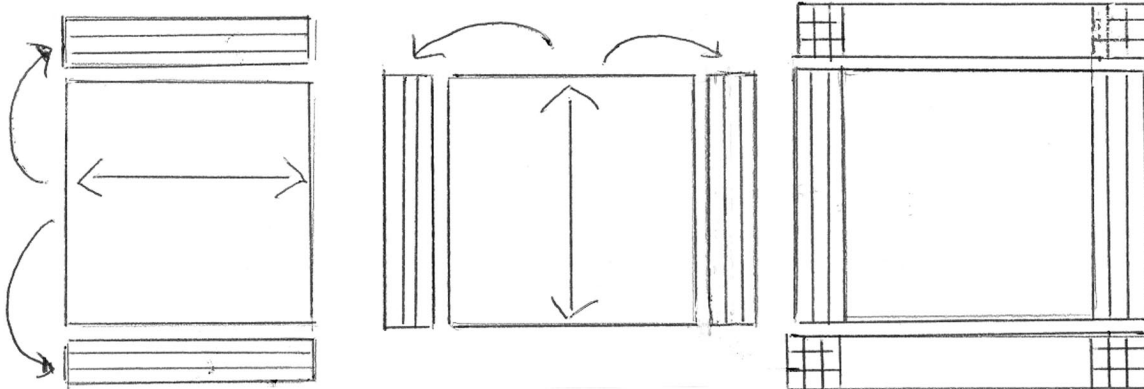
Sew a L D L strip together  
Sew a D L D strip together  
Sew a L D Novelty strip



Cross cut at 2 1/2" to get (4)  
Strip-sets from each strata

Sew together to as pictured to make (4) 9-patches.

Measure across your quilt at the middle and cut two border strata that length for the corresponding sides. Sew to sides parallel sides to the quilt. Then sew a 9-patch to each end of the last two strips being careful of placement of novelty corner. Sew this strip to the quilt.



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
