EASY PLACEMATS

Use linen, linen cotton blend or decorator weight fabric.

Thread for top stitching

Chalk-o-liner for marking stitching lines

¼" Steam-A-Seam fusible tape

7/8 Yard Makes (2) 42" Wide Fabric,

1 ¾ Yard Makes (4)

2 ½ Yards Makes (6)

54" Wide Fabric

5/8 Yard Makes (4)

1 ¼ Yard Makes (8)

Linen shrinks, so to avoid any problems, pre-wash in warm, line dry.

1. Cut two 12 ½" x 18 ½" rectangles for each mat. See cutting below.

2. Place right sides together and sew around with a ¼" seam allowance, leaving a four inch opening in the middle of one end.

3. Trim the corner tips, turn right side out and press. Fold the opening edges in to line up with the edge, fuse closed with the ¼" Steam-A-Seam.

4. Draw a chalk line 4" on from long sides and one 6" in from ends. Change stitch length to a 3 and top stitch on the lines. Be careful with back-stitching as it can show. Instead, stitch two times in the same hole by putting stitch length at 0 or by holding mat so it can't move for the second stitch.
