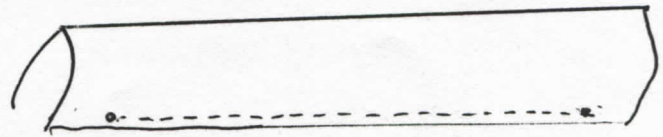


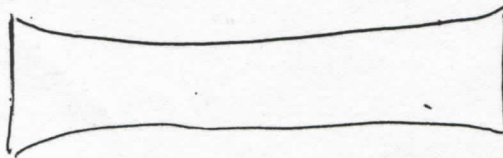
CUDDLE INFINITY SCARF - IN 10 MINUTES

1/3 yard "Cuddle", "Minkee" or other soft fiber
Air fluff 10 minutes in the dryer to catch the "fuzzies" (3 pieces maximum in dryer at a time or you may over fill the lint screen)

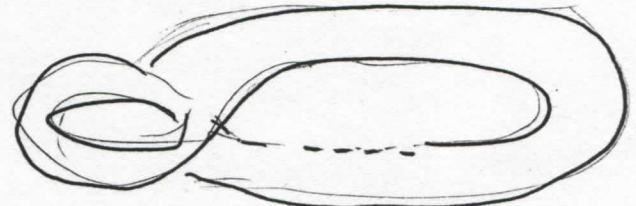
Fold right sides together, the long way. Sew, starting 3" from one end and sewing to 3" from the other end. (Leave ends open) I use about a 3/8" seam allowance, the edge of my presser foot or walking foot.



Turn right side out and put seam on the bottom.



Turn one end of the scarf one revolution before sewing ends right side together.. Give the scarf a little tug and you are done except for hand sewing the 6" opening together.



If you want a stripe of color in your scarf sew two colors together before following above directions. Be sure to sew end to end, not leaving the 3" open on the pieced seam. I like to use a 9" x 60" piece and a 4 1/2" x 60" piece, but any combination to make 12 inches plus seam allowance works.
